These boxes protect internal wiring, circuit breakers, and other electrical components, but they do not measure, monitor, or control process variables themselves .

Difference Between Instruments and Enclosures

- **Instruments:** Devices like pressure transmitters, temperature sensors, and flow meters that measure, monitor, or control process parameters in hazardous areas. Explosion-proof instruments may have thick enclosures to contain internal explosions, but their primary function is data acquisition or control .
- **Explosion-Proof Distribution Boxes:** Serve as protective housings for electrical circuits and connections. They ensure that any internal fault does not ignite the external atmosphere but do not perform measurement or control functions, so they...
