

Are fiber optic cables heavier than electrical cables

Construction and Material Differences

Fiber optic cables are composed of thin strands of glass or plastic fibers that transmit data as light signals. They include a core, cladding, and an outer protective layer, often reinforced with materials like Kevlar for strength, but they do not require heavy metal conductors or thick insulation. The typical fiber diameter is very small, around 125 microns for glass fibers, with tight-buffered cables around 900 microns. Electrical cables, on the other hand, use metal conductors such as copper or aluminum, which are significantly denser than glass or plastic. These conductors are insulated with materials like PVC or rubber, and multiple strands may be bundled together, increasing the overall diameter and weight. Coaxial or power cables also include additional shielding and protective layers, further adding to their mass.

Weight Implications

Because metals like copper have a high density, electrical cables are much heavier per unit length compared to fiber optic cables. Fiber optic cables are lighter, more flexible, and easier to handle, which is why they are preferred for long-distance data transmission and installations where weight is a concern. For example, a standard fiber optic cable drum of 2 km is manageable, whereas an equivalent length of cop...
