Cable Type and Quantity: Identify all low-voltage cables, including Ethernet (Cat6/6A/7), fiber optic, coaxial, and control cables. Note their outer diameters and total quantity, including a 20–30% margin for future expansion, to calculate the total weight per meter and ensure the tray can support it safely . **Tray Type:**

- **Wire Mesh Trays:** Ideal for low-voltage and data cables, offering excellent ventilation, flexibility, and easy access for maintenance. Patented designs like Safe-T-Edge protect cables from fraying and installers from sharp edges .
- **Cable Ladders:** Provide superior strength and ventilation, suitable for heavier bundles or areas requiring robust support .
- Bend Radius and Routing:** Ensure the tray accommodates the minimum bend radius of sensitive cables, especially fiber optics, to prevent signal degradation. Plan straight, short pathways and minimize unnecessary bends or crossovers .
- Separation and EMI Considerations:** Maintain vertical and horizontal separation between low-voltage and high-voltage cables, typically at least 12 inches, or use metal partitions to reduce electromagnetic interference .
- Material and Environmental Factors:** Use steel, stainless steel, or coated aluminum trays for corrosion resistance. Consider heat dissipation, humidity...
