

Cables can be overlapped in cable trays



Article Overview

Cables should generally not be overlapped in cable trays; proper spacing and single-layer installation are required for safety and compliance.

NEC and Industry Guidelines

According to NEC Article 392, cable trays are designed to support and organize electrical, control, and communication cables, but overlapping or stacking cables is restricted depending on cable type and size . For example:

- Large single-conductor cables (1000 kcmil and larger) must be installed in a single layer with no stacking, and the sum of cable diameters must not exceed the tray width .
- Medium-sized single-conductor cables (250 kcmil to 900 kcmil) also require a single layer, though spacing may be adjusted for ampacity derating purposes .
- Smaller single-conductor cables (1/0 to 4/0 AWG) can be installed in a single layer or in circuit groups bound together, but random overlapping is prohibited to prevent inductive heating and fire hazards .

Reasons Against Overlapping

- Heat Dissipation: Overlapping cables reduces airflow, increasing the risk of overheating and ampacity derating issues .
- Maintenance and Access: Single-layer installation allows easier identification, removal, and replacement of cables .
- Code Compliance: NEC and industry standards specify maximum fill percentages (typically 40-50% of tray area) and require proper separation between power and si...
