How It Works

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other . The connector end plugs directly into equipment, patch panels, or optical distribution frames, while the bare fiber end is intended to be fusion-spliced or mechanically spliced to the single optical fiber in the field . This allows the single fiber to interface with standard connectors without requiring field termination, which is often less precise and more prone to signal loss.

Why Use a Pigtail

- Flexibility: Pigtails allow single fibers from bulk cables to be terminated at distribution points, patch panels, or ODFs without pre-connectorizing the entire cable .
