The standard 12-core optical fiber color sequence is: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose (Pink), Aqua.

Standard 12-Fiber Sequence

For a 12-core optical fiber cable, each fiber is color-coded to allow easy identification during installation and maintenance. The TIA/EIA-598-C standard specifies the following order:

- Blue
 - Orange
 - Green
 - Brown
 - Slate (Gray)
 - White
 - Red
 - Black
 - Yellow
 - Violet
 - Rose (Pink)
 - Aqua
- This sequence is universally applied to single 12-core cables, as well as to fibers within ribbon cables and loose-tube cables .
