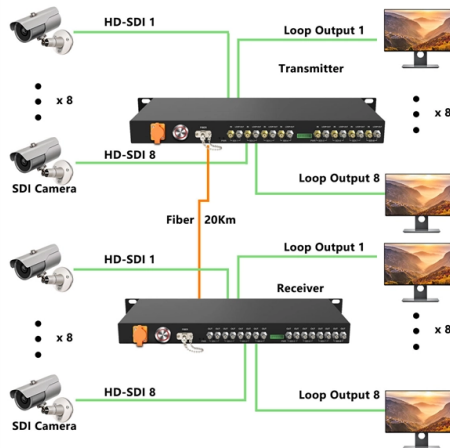


Do China Mobile and China Telecom share fiber optic cables



Overview

As they find it increasingly difficult to partner with Western network operators, China Telecom, China Mobile, and China Unicom have banded together to deploy their own submarine cable system that will connect Asia, the Middle East, and Europe, Reuters reports. China Mobile released details regarding the awards of their 2025/2026 loose-tube optical cable tender on 7 June 2025 – less than one month after announcing the tender on 8 May 2025. As anticipated, competition for the 98.8M F-km optical cable tender was intense. The estimated scale of this centralized procurement of ordinary optical fiber cables is 4,470,500 skin-length kilometers (equivalent to 143. The NCP cable system consists seven fiber pairs, initially. The Europe-Middle East-Asia (EMA) submarine network will use a route that roughly parallels the upcoming Southeast Asia-Middle East-Western Europe-6 (SeaMeWe-6) undersea system, according to the report. The proposed EMA (Europe-Middle East-Asia) cable would connect Hong Kong to China's island. We understand China Mobile has been encouraged by major fibre and cable producers in China to announce the results as soon as possible to support market sentiment, as the initial tender release has been delayed by more than six months. 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China Telecom and China Mobile pulled out of the project after SubCom won the contract last year and, along with China Unicom, began planning the EMA cable, the four people involved said.
