

Elevation of cable trays and ducts



Article Overview

Cable trays and ducts should be installed at elevations that ensure proper clearance, safe operation, and compliance with standards, typically maintaining at least 300 mm vertical clearance from ducts and following MEP elevation guidelines.

Determining Elevation

The elevation of cable trays and ducts is defined by the vertical distance from a reference point, such as the floor or ceiling, to the top, bottom, or centerline of the element. In MEP design software, multiple elevation parameters can be used, including:

- Top of insulation at the lower or upper end
 - Bottom of the element or insulation
 - Centerline of the element
 - Interior top or base of the pipe or duct
- These parameters allow precise placement and scheduling of MEP elements in complex installations, ensuring proper alignment and coordination with other systems .

Safety Clearances

Maintaining adequate vertical and horizontal clearances is critical to prevent interference, overheating, and maintenance issues. Recommended clearances include:

- Vertical clearance: At least 300 mm between the top of a cable tray and the botto...
