

Height of cable trays across roads



Article Overview

Cable trays crossing roads should maintain a minimum clearance of approximately 300 mm above the road surface, with exact heights determined by local codes and traffic requirements.

Minimum Clearance Guidelines

For cable trays installed over roads or public passageways, a minimum vertical clearance of 300 mm (about 12 inches) above the road or walkway is generally recommended to allow safe vehicle passage and maintenance access . This clearance ensures that the tray is accessible for cable installation and future maintenance while preventing interference with traffic or vehicles.

Standards and Compliance

- NEC and IEC Standards: Cable trays must comply with NEC 392 and IEC 61537, which govern installation, grounding, and support requirements .
- Material and Load Considerations: Trays should be made of galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum alloys to withstand environmental stressors such as vibration, temperature extremes, and de-icing salts .
- Support Spacing: Supports should be installed at intervals that prevent sagging, typically no more than 600 mm apart near bends and according to the tray manufacturer's specifications .
- Future Expansion: A minimum of 30% additional capacity is recommended to accommodate future cable additions
