Fiber optic communication offers extremely high bandwidth, but its limits are determined by physical properties, fiber type, distance, and signal processing technologies.

Bandwidth Fundamentals

Fiber optic bandwidth refers to the maximum data rate a fiber can transmit, typically measured in gigabits per second (Gbps) or terabits per second (Tbps) depending on the system . Unlike copper cables, fiber transmits data using light pulses, allowing speeds near the speed of light and minimal signal loss over long distances . The bandwidth-distance product is a key concept: a fiber rated at 500 MHz·km can carry 500 MHz over 1 km or 250 MHz over 2 km, illustrating the inverse relationship between bandwidth and distance .

Factors Limiting Bandwidth

- Fiber Type
 - Single-mode fiber (SMF) has a small core, supporting long-distance transmission with minimal dispersion, making it ideal for high-bandwidth, long-haul applications .
 - Multi-mode fiber (MMF) has a larger core, suitable for shorter distances but more prone to modal dispersion, which limits bandwidth over longer spans .
