Just like virtual CPUs (vCPUs) relate to physical CPUs in cloud computing, kW/rack defines power use per server rack. This impacts colocation pricing, energy use. Most data-center racks are 19-inch EIA-310 frames in 42U–52U height, 600–800 mm width, 1000–1200 mm depth, rated 1000–1500 kg static with front-to-back airflow, bonded to a site earthing bar via a dedicated M8/M10 earth stud; performance depends on correct cable management, blanking, and aisle. In an electrical circuit, a unit of apparent power is given by kilovolt-amperes (kVA), which means it is arrived at by multiplying voltage by current. Kilowatts (kW), on the other hand, measure real power (the electricity that is used or consumed), while kVA includes both real and reactive powers.
