

Meaning of various signals in relay protection



Article Overview

In relay protection, signals such as trip, alarm, pickup, and auxiliary indicate fault detection, operational status, and control actions to isolate faulty sections and maintain system stability.

Key Signals in Relay Protection

1. Trip Signal The trip signal is the primary output of a protective relay. When the relay detects a fault or abnormal condition, it sends a trip signal to the circuit breaker to disconnect the faulty section from the rest of the system, preventing equipment damage and maintaining system stability . 2. Alarm Signal An alarm signal notifies operators of abnormal conditions without immediately tripping the breaker. It is used for monitoring purposes, allowing preventive action before a fault escalates . 3. Pickup Signal The pickup signal represents the threshold level of current or voltage at which the relay begins to operate. Once the actuating quantity exceeds this level, the relay mechanism starts moving toward closing its contacts . 4. Dropout (Reset) Signal The dropout or reset signal is the value below which the relay returns to its normal state, opening its contacts and stopping the trip or alarm action . 5. Operating Time Operating time is the duration from when the actuating quantity exceeds the pickup level to when the relay contacts close. It ensures selective and timely operation, avoiding unnecessary tripping of upstream devices . 6. Auxiliary Signals Auxiliary signals include outputs for breaker failure, supervision, or interlocking. For example, a breaker failure relay sends a signal if the breaker does not operate after a trip command, initiating backup protection . 7. Directional Signals Directional relays pro...
