

Number of circuits marked on the distribution box



Article Overview

The number of circuits on a distribution box corresponds to the individual breaker switches (MCBs) that control separate electrical loads, excluding main switches and RCDs.

Understanding Circuit Count

A distribution box (or fuseboard) contains multiple circuit breakers, each protecting a specific electrical circuit in your home or building. To determine the number of circuits:

- Count the individual breaker switches: Each single-pole or double-pole breaker represents a separate circuit .
- Include 3-phase breakers: Triple-width breakers for three-phase circuits should also be counted as individual circuits .
- Exclude main switches and RCDs: The main switch and residual current devices (RCDs) are not counted as separate circuits .

Labeling and Identification

Each circuit is usually marked with a unique number or label on the panel, which helps identify the area or appliance it serves . Standard labeling practices include:

- Sequential numbering: Circuits are numbered from top to bottom or left to right....
