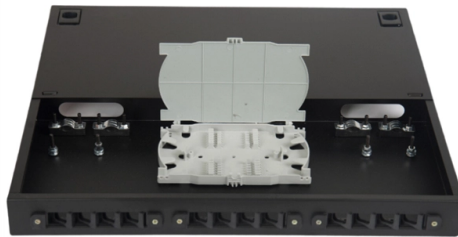


Operating current of the circuit breaker in the primary distribution box



Article Overview

The operating current of a circuit breaker in a primary distribution box is determined by the rated current of the installation, the load characteristics, and environmental factors, typically matching the maximum continuous load current while allowing for safe overload protection.

Determining the Operating Current

The operating current of a circuit breaker is essentially its rated current, which is the maximum continuous current the breaker can carry without tripping under normal conditions. For low-voltage distribution systems, this rating is usually defined at a reference ambient temperature of 40°C for industrial-type breakers according to IEC 60947 standards . The rated current should be selected based on:

- Load characteristics: Total connected load, type of equipment (motors, lighting, resistive loads), and expected peak currents.
- Cable and busbar ratings: The breaker must protect the conductors from overheating.
- Environmental conditions: If the breaker is installed in a hot enclosure or near heat sources, the tripping current may be derated. Conversely, cooler environments can allow slight up-rating .
