

Precautions for splicing different optical cables

Proper precautions during optical cable splicing are essential to protect both the technician and the fiber network, including the use of PPE, careful handling of fibers, and adherence to splicing procedures.

Personal Safety Measures

- Wear appropriate PPE: Safety glasses, gloves, and disposable aprons protect against fiber shards and chemical exposure from adhesives or cleaning agents used during splicing .
- Avoid direct eye exposure to laser light: Ensure all fiber ends are dark or disconnected from active light sources to prevent retinal damage .
- Handle fiber fragments carefully: Use tweezers to pick up cleaved fiber pieces and place them on tape to prevent skin punctures or contamination .

Workspace and Equipment Safety

- Maintain a clean work area: Fiber particles can contaminate surfaces and be ingested if transferred to food or drink .
- Ensure power sources are disconnected: Both AC/DC and laser sources should be off to prevent electrical shock or accidental laser exposure .
- Clean splicing equipment regularly: Fusion splicer components such as the V-groove, electrodes, and lenses should be free of dust and fiber fragments to avoid poor splices or equipment damage
