

Safety in the Production of Communication Towers



Overview

48 standard establishes minimum safety criteria for communication and broadcast tower work across the United States. It is not a standard or regulation, and it neither creates new legal obligations nor alters existing obligations created by OSHA standards or the Occupational Safety and Health Act. Pursuant to the OSH Act, employers must comply with safety and health standards and regulations issued and enforced. For 30 years, there has been an increase in communication towers for 911 services, cell phones, electricity transmission, and more.
