

Should the cable tray cover be sealed



Overview

Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with design requirements. That is, it covers the top section of the cable tray. They vary in design. Scope: Firestopping for busway, cable trays, cables, and trunking passing through walls in enclosed electrical installations. These essential components: Example: Stainless steel covers meet NEC 392. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require.
