

Single-mode fiber optic transceiver wiring TX or RS



Article Overview

For single-mode fiber optic transceivers, always connect the TX (transmit) port of one transceiver to the RX (receive) port of the other, and vice versa; RS ports are used only for serial signal conversion, not optical transmission.

Understanding TX and RX in Fiber Optics

Single-mode fiber optic transceivers have two key ports: TX (transmit) and RX (receive). The TX port sends optical signals, while the RX port receives optical signals from the opposite transceiver . Proper operation requires a crossed connection: the TX of one device must connect to the RX of the other, ensuring bidirectional communication over two fibers or a duplex cable . Connecting TX to TX or RX to RX will prevent data transmission.

RS Ports and Serial-to-Fiber Converters

RS-232, RS-422, or RS-485 ports are electrical serial interfaces used to communicate with devices like PLCs, sensors, or computers . When using a fiber optic transceiver for serial communication, the RS port connects to the host device, and the transceiver converts the electrical signals to optical signals for transmission over single-mode fiber . The optical TX/RX ports handle the fiber link, while the RS port handles the device interface.
