

Spacing of cable tray supports in power distribution room



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should generally be spaced 4 to 6 feet apart for horizontal runs, with rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches depending on tray type and cable load.

Horizontal Support Spacing

For horizontal runs, the National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that cable trays must be supported at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, but not exceeding 5 feet (1.5 meters) to safely carry the weight of cables and any additional loads such as wind or seismic forces . A practical range for most installations is 4 to 6 feet (1.2 to 1.8 meters), ensuring uniform support and preventing sagging . Ladder-type trays should have rungs spaced no more than 9 inches (230 mm) apart to provide adequate support for heavy power cables . Perforated and wire mesh trays may require closer support depending on cable weight and environmental conditions .

Vertical and Floor-Mounted Spacing

For vertical runs or floor-mounted trays, a minimum clearance of 150 mm (6 inches) between trays is recommended to allow for ventilation, heat dissipation, and future cable additions . Supports should be designed to maintain tray stability and prevent stress on cables at bends or turns .
