

Splitter ports can be bound



Article Overview

Splitter ports can be bound or assigned depending on the type of splitter and network architecture, allowing specific inputs to correspond to designated outputs for redundancy, centralized control, or device allocation.

Optical Splitters

In Passive Optical Networks (PONs), splitters distribute optical signals from a single OLT port to multiple ONTs. Splitters can have 1:N ports (one input, multiple outputs) or 2:N ports (two inputs for redundancy) and can be configured to bind specific outputs to certain customers or locations .

- Centralized splitting allows flexible binding: outputs can be reassigned to different ONTs using jumpers at a central office or cabinet .
- Distributed splitting is fixed: once installed in closures or pedestals, the output ports are permanently assigned and cannot be re-bound without physical reconfiguration .
- Non-uniform splitters can allocate different power levels to specific outputs, effectively binding higher bandwidth or priority to certain ports . This binding is crucial for network planning, ensuring redundancy, and optimizing bandwidth distribution.

Ethernet Splitters

For Ethernet splitters, binding is more limited. Passive splitters simply divide the cable pairs among multiple ports, so each output is tied to a specific pair of wires a...
