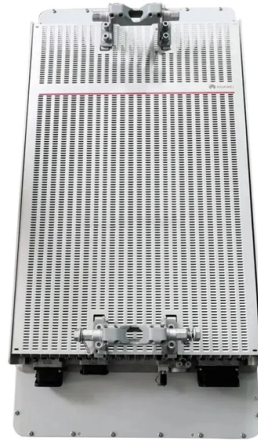


Tail fiber colors red yellow green

In fiber optic cables, red, yellow, and green are standard colors used to identify individual fibers or buffer tubes, helping technicians correctly manage, splice, and connect fibers.

Standard Color Coding

Fiber optic cables follow the TIA/EIA-598-C standard, which defines a sequence of colors for identifying individual fibers in a 12-fiber group. The standard 12-fiber color sequence is: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose (Pink), Aqua (Light Blue). In this sequence:

- Red is the 7th fiber in the group.
- Yellow is the 9th fiber.
- Green is the 3rd fiber. This sequence repeats for cables with more than 12 fibers, often organized into tubes or bundles, with each tube also color-coded for easy identification during installation and maintenance .

Purpose of Color Coding

The colors serve several practical purposes:

- Identification: Each fiber or tube can be quickly recognized, reducing errors during splicing or patching .
- Organization: In multi-fiber cables, colored fibers help technicians match fibers correctly in splice trays or patch panels
