Overview of PON Users

PON technology is primarily deployed for last-mile connectivity, linking Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to end-users through a point-to-multipoint topology. A single optical fiber from the ISP is split via passive optical splitters to serve multiple endpoints, allowing cost-effective and efficient broadband delivery .

Residential Users

- Homes and apartments are the most common PON users, especially in Fiber to the Home (FTTH) deployments.
- PON provides high-speed internet, voice, and video services directly to households, supporting streaming, gaming, and remote work .

Commercial and Institutional Users

- Businesses, hotels, and hospitals benefit from PON for reliable, high-bandwidth connectivity without the need for powered equipment between the central office and the user .
- High-density buildings, such as apartment complexes or office towers, use PON to efficiently distribute fiber to multiple tenants through a single fiber line
