Safety Precautions

Before starting, always wear safety glasses and gloves to protect against sharp glass fibers and chemical exposure (). Ensure the cable is de-energized and use a non-contact voltage tester if applicable (). Avoid excessive bending, pulling, or crushing the cable, as this can worsen damage ().

Step 1: Inspect and Locate Damage

Perform a visual inspection to identify cuts, kinks, or exposed fibers (). For internal damage not visible externally, use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to locate breaks and measure signal loss (). Accurate fault location prevents unnecessary cutting and ensures proper repair.

Carefully cut out the damaged portion of the cable using a fiber optic cutter, leaving enough length for stripping and splicing (). Trim frayed or torn ends to create clean, undamaged fiber ends....
