Direct-buried optical cables are designed for underground installation and primarily include loose-tube, ribbon, and armored constructions, each tailored for specific environmental and mechanical protection needs.

Main Types of Direct-Buried Optical Cables

1. Loose-Tube Cables Loose-tube cables contain optical fibers housed in buffer tubes, which may be gel-filled or gel-free to prevent water ingress. They are ideal for long outdoor runs because the tube protects fibers from microbending and moisture. Fiber counts typically range from 12 to 432 fibers, making them suitable for high-capacity backbone networks. These cables are lightweight, flexible, and durable for easy handling and installation in trenches or via plowing . 2. Ribbon Cables Ribbon cables organize fibers in flat ribbons, often with 12 fibers per ribbon, allowing mass-fusion splicing for faster installation and maintenance. They are high-density and lightweight, supporting fiber counts up to 864 fibers. Ribbon cables are particularly useful in data-intensive environments where rapid deployment and high fiber density are required . 3. Armored Direct-Burial Cables Armored cables include a metal layer, typically corrugated steel tape (CST) or steel wire, beneath the outer jacket. This provides strong protection against mechanical stress, rodent damage, and crushing forces. Armored cables are recommended for areas with high mechanical risk, such as road crossings, rocky soil, or locations prone to excavation .
