

What causes the pigtail fiber to break

Pigtail fibers can break due to improper handling, excessive bending, splicing errors, environmental stress, or physical damage to the fiber or connector.

Physical Handling and Bend Radius Violations

Fiber optic pigtails are delicate, with a typical diameter of 0.9mm for standard single-mode or multi-mode fibers . Exceeding the minimum bend radius (commonly 10mm for standard single-mode fibers) can cause microbends or macrobends, leading to fiber breakage or signal loss . Improper pulling, twisting, or crushing during installation can also physically fracture the fiber.

Splicing and Connector Issues

The bare end of a pigtail is designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to the main fiber cable . Incorrect splicing techniques, such as misalignment of cores, air gaps, or mismatched polish types (UPC vs. APC), can weaken the fiber at the splice point, making it prone to breakage . Damaged ferrule end-faces, including pits, chips, or angular misalignment, can also compromise the fiber's integrity.

Environmental and External Stress

Outdoor or industrial deployments expose pigtails to thermal stress, UV exposure, or chemical corrosion, which can degrade the fiber jacket and increase the risk of breakage over time . Rodent damage or accidental crushing in underground or aerial installations is another common cause. Extreme temperature fluctuations can induc...
