- Collapsed Core Architecture

- It reduces the number of devices, simplifies management, and is suitable for networks with fewer than 150 devices.
- This approach avoids the need for a dedicated enterprise-grade core switch while still providing reliable backbone connectivity.
- Small Layer 3 Managed Switches
- Layer 3 switches with moderate port counts and 10G uplinks can serve as a simple core.
- They provide routing capabilities, VLAN support, and basic QoS without the compl...
