Utility Infrastructure and Hybrid Cables

Electrical utilities frequently install fiber optic cables alongside power lines on poles or towers to support communication and monitoring systems. This is achieved using specialized cables such as Optical Ground Wire (OPGW), Optical Power Phase Conductor (OPPC), or Optical Power Attached Cable (OPAC), which integrate optical fibers with metallic conductors or are attached to existing power conductors. These designs allow fiber to share the same physical route as electrical cables without being affected by the high-voltage currents, because the glass fibers are inherently immune to electromagnetic interference.

Safety and Grounding Considerations

Although fiber itself is non-conductive, some fiber cables include metallic strength members or tone wires for locating purposes. When these metallic components are exposed to electrical conductors, grounding or insulating joints may be required according to codes like the National Electrical Code (NEC 770.93) to ensure safety. This ensures that any accidental contact with power lines does not create a hazard, while the fiber remains electrically isolated and functional....
